
President-elect candidates



Dr. Shi is an Assistant Professor in the Department of Biosystems and Agricultural Engineering at University of Kentucky. He got his MS from China Agricultural University and PhD from North Carolina State University and lately worked at national lab and industry before joining the faculty in 2015. Dr. Shi has a long history serving the AOC community. He participated the student activity committee (SAC) during 2005-2007 and designed the earliest SAC website. He serves as the web manager since 2016 and the Vice President of AOC during 2017-18 term. If selected as President-Elect, he will help to strengthen the core value of AOCABFE: "Connection" – improve

networking between colleagues and institutions in US and China, and beyond; "Fostering" – formalize mentor/mentee and advising mechanisms for young AOC members; and "Friendship" – host events and activities for AOC members *via* new platforms. He will continue engage in AOC board and contribute to the growth and success of this great association.

My name is **Yufeng Ge** and I am Assistant Professor at Biological Systems Engineering at University of Nebraska-Lincoln. My involvement with AOC started 12 years ago, first as a graduate student and then faculty member. I was Secretary, Newsletter Editor, and now am Treasurer. 


Member-at-large candidates

I received my Ph.D. degree in Biosystems Engineering from Michigan State University in 2011, continued my research at MSU/ USDA-ARS Lab as a Postdoctoral Research Associate, and joined Zhejiang University as a China's 1000 Young Talent in 2015. My research is focused on agro-optics and imaging, including fundamental understanding of light interaction with plant materials and engineering applications of optical sensingbased plant phenotyping and agricultural machinery. I have been an ASABE



Member and AOC Member for 10 years. I serve as an Associate Editor of ASABE ITSC Technical Community, a Vice Chair of ASABE Machine Vision committee (ITSC-312), and a Session Moderator in ASABE Annual meetings. I enjoy working with colleagues and students to promote the development of our community, and would like to continue making contributions, especially for promoting the China-US research collaboration and student-exchange in AOC Community, and help to advance the impact of AOC in China. I would appreciate your vote for me very much.



Dr. Yi Wang is an Assistant Professor in the Biosystems Engineering Department at Auburn University. He received his B.S. from University of Science and Technology Beijing in 2003, M.S. from University of Science and Technology of China in 2006, and Ph.D. from University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign in 2012. Dr. Wang's research interests lie primarily in the area of value-added biochemical and bioenergy production through bioprocess engineering, metabolic engineering, and synthetic biology approaches. Dr. Wang has been an AOC member since the ASABE Annual Meeting in Kansas City in 2013. As a graduate student, Post-doc and early-career investigator by now, Dr. Wang has benefited greatly from the AOC community. Now, he is eager to contribute to this com-

- 1. The agenda is approved without any addition.
- 2. The minutes recorded at the <u>December 1st 2017</u> board meeting was approved.
- 3. Zhiming updated recent activities on his side. A congratulation letter was drafted and approved by the board on March 11, 2018. This letter congratulated the opening of a new college in agricultural engineering and sciences at Hohai University, Nanjing, China. Zhiming will invite guests to present the award banquet. Since this year our award will be scheduled on Tuesday, it may be very difficult to invite ASABE president/staff due to the conflict with the ASABE Foundation meeting. Zhiming wish that next year it will be scheduled back to Monday. This was partially due to our late response to ASABE about scheduling our events. Next year hopefully we will contact Jessica Bell (bell@asabe.org) or Sharon McKnight (mcknight@asabe.org) at ASABE at least in January to schedule the meeting.
- 4. Institutional Membership, president-elect nomination, and three faculty award: Dr. Yanbo Huang (Past President) will take care of all those items. Three faculty award are: Early Career Award, Distinguished Career Award, and Outstanding Service Award. The due date of those award was set on June 1 in 2017. We should put those ads in our wetchat group. Dr. Huang mentioned that Dr. Liping Che would like to continue with the service on institutional membership.
- 5. Treasures report was skipped due to the absence of Dr. Yufeng Ge who is travelling in China.
- 6. Website update, business meeting and banquet: Dr. Jian Shi was absent due to a meeting at LSU. Dr. Shi later video chatted with Dr. Zhiming Qi and updated few things about website and restaurant. Jian has targeted at German Town as the potential place for the award banquet, but also left on-site catering as an option. Zhiming will send him the program used in 2017.
- 7. NERCITA China Exchange Forum, AOC Fellow, and plaque for past president: Dr. Hong Li will handle all those items and will start inviting speakers. There is one more candidate in the AOC Fellow pool and Hong will follow up with this nomination and check whether it is still valid or needs update according to the regulation. Dr. Yanbo Huang suggested a speaker from China Agricultural University.
- 8. IMPACT Newsletter: Dr. Lilong Cai mentioned that this recent issue is almost ready except for an interview with Dr. Xiao Wu. Lilong will add advertisement on the fellow, awards and competition. Minliang Yang is now the major Associate Editor for this current issue.
- 9. Membership update and presentation competition award: Dr. Liangcheng Yang reported that the total number of AOC is totaled of 61. Liangcheng will continue with the presentation competition award.
- 10. ASABE China symposium: Drs. Yang Zhao and Xiao Wu will keep it rolling. Yang obtained all the documents from Ms. Jessica Bell and was informed that it may take about two years to finalize it. ASABE would not be able to provide funding so financial support should be retrieved from exhibitors or other industrial sponsors. Yanbo suggested to contact Dr. Yingkuan Wang about the 2018 FAO-ITU E-agriculture Solutions Forum and check if we can add an ASABE session sponsored by AOC.

- 11. Logo: A letter has been drafted by Dr. Yeyin Shi to clarify and inform the AOC community about the change in logo. Key dates are verified by Dr. Jian Shi via email and will be released through mail-list and IMPACT.
- 12. SAC update: The Board suggest SAC to resume the traditional gathering dinner but charge \$10 dollars for the dinner and make it open to all students. AOC will cover the rest of the cost beyond \$10. Traditionally speakers are invited to talk at this gathering dinner. SAC dinner has to be scheduled on Monday since AOC meeting is on Tuesday this year. Mr. Jiangong Li demonstrated the Wechat public account to the Board and plan to release news in incoming consecutive weeks. A few interviews over ABE senior graduates will be released. Jiangong expressed the stress in lack of article or contribution which is submitted to them. Dr. Yang Zhao suggested to publish some articles associated with travel and fun, besides research and job hunting. Zhiming suggested to invite students in Michigan to draft a guidance of fun places to visit near Detroit where ASABE will be held this year.
- 13. Student Career Development: Dr. Haibo Huang is actively searching for approaches to move it forward. He elaborated the pattern of IFT in which 4-5 professors are involved to help students about career development. It seems a large project. Dr. Yanbo Huang suggest to build a committee led by Haibo if necessary. Dr. Liangcheng Yang gave a short brief about his experience when leading this program. Webinars were organized to introduce students about career development. Haibo suggested everyone to collect job information so that it can be released through this stream.
- 14. Others: Zhiming suggested Hong to attend the E2050 committee meeting. Zhiming will contact Dr. Naiqian Zhang to remind him about the student awards.
- 15. Meeting adjourn.





我们先来了解一下会议的地理位置和周边。



废话不多,先来说说游玩地点。


科博中心Cobo Center






底特律艺术馆(Detroit Institute of Arts)

底特律美术馆(Detroit Institute of Arts)建立于1885年,自称是美国排名第六的博物馆,2003年曾被评为美国第二大市属博物馆,馆内有100多个画廊,藏品包罗万象,对艺术文化发展的历史整理也很完备,陈列着来自世界各地的著名美术珍品。可分为非洲、大洋洲和美洲原住民艺术,美国艺术,亚洲和伊斯兰国家艺术、欧洲艺术、当代艺术和表演艺术等。馆藏的名贵作品包括梵高的《自画像》、迪戈•里维拉的《底特律的工业》以及奥古斯特•罗丹的雕塑作品《思考者》。

Henry Ford Museum


距离downtown一段距离的Henry Ford Museum也是 很受欢迎的游玩去处。
